



### About the university:

The University of Navarra is a Catholic University founded in 1952 and has recently been ranked among the best by [“The Herald Tribune”](#) and ranked as the 4th best Spanish university in Europe according to the Times Higher Education QS University Ranking.

It has 4 Campuses, the [IESE](#) Business School in Madrid, Barcelona and New York, and the main campus in Pamplona, which has 17 Faculties and Schools (and including [University of Navarra Hospital](#) and the [CIMA](#) Medical Research Center), and the Technological Campus in San Sebastian, which hosts Tecnun and [CEIT](#), an affiliated Research Centre.

Tecnun is ranked as the 1<sup>st</sup> private Spanish Engineering School and it is 3<sup>rd</sup> in global ranking, according to the Spanish ranking in “El Mundo”.

TECNUN offers new degrees in the Bch/Ms model (4+1) according to the post-"Bolonia Agreement" that started at Tecnun in year 2009-2010.
